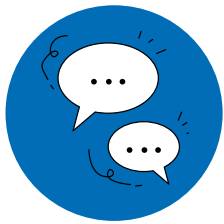

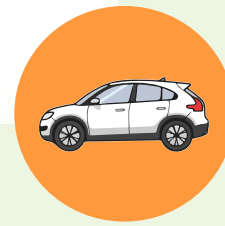
COMMUNITY COMPANIONS
